At the June 18 regular meeting, the Wayne Township Board of Education warmly welcomed two new administrators into the district and promoted two current employees to principal positions. Erica Cerilli-Levine was appointed as the new Assistant Director of Student Support Services. Mrs. Cerilli-Levine is currently the Supervisor of Special Education for the Fairfield Public Schools. Prior to her work in Fairfield, she was a special education teacher in Montville. She started her educational career as public school teacher in Manhattan.
